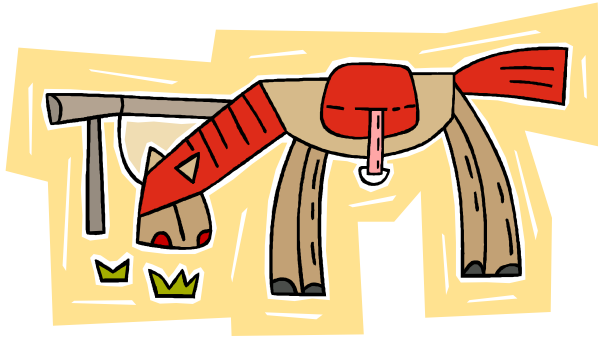

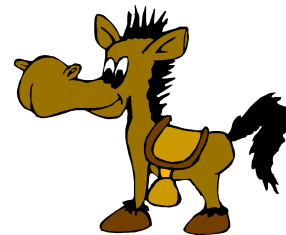
If you wish to leave your group for any reason, you must talk to your instructor FIRST. When leaving a group WALK, do not trot or canter.

Riders must not get on their horse unless wearing their helmets.

If you are late to muster, please wait until you have been gear-checked before you join the group.

Please know that all members are able to use the arena at any time. However, we must ask that everyone sign the Arena Usage Book which is kept in the box on the wall up on the verandah. Please note that if you are using the arena, you must follow PCAQ rules as far as equipment goes e.g. helmet, boots, no western saddles etc. This is necessary because of our insurance. If you are not sure of the equipment rules, please ask.
